Fabric Requirements:
Backing - 24" square
Fusible batting - 24" square
Binding - 1/4 yard
Background - 1/2 yard
32 - 4 1/2" squares
(4 1/2" squares can be one color or multi
colored/scrappy)

Cutting Instructions for background: 1-6" square

2- 3"x 16" rectangles

4-3"x 12" rectangles

8- 3"x 11" rectangles

2-3"x 6" rectangles

QUIP Diaper Donations


A huge thank you to all of the members who donated diapers at the December QUIP meeting!





Quip General Meeting Minutes ~ December 5, 2024

President Kay Walker called the meeting to order at 9:58 am. Sandy made a motion to approve the minutes, and Charlotte seconded the motion. Minutes were approved. Members in attendance were Shirley Brown, Iris Biasetti, Denise Glaser, Kay Walker, Barbara Tate, Sandy Glazer, Anne Brumet, Judy Nemeth, Charlotte Lorenzo, and Sheri Passwater. There was a quorum present.

Financial Report: Checking balance: \$7275.75, Savings balance was \$5107.17 Workshops and Retreats: We may have 20 people attending the next retreat on April 4-7. Openings to attend the retreat are limited, so signup to attend soon. December will be QUIP's Holiday party. January will be a sit and sew to make a table topper.

Programs: December program will be the holiday celebration. January program will be Nina demonstrating how to do borders and bindings. February program will be about our favorite tools. **SFQE:** There will be 3 classes held at the expo. Beginning quilting, foam fabric board pictures, and reverse applique. The website asks you to pick your color for the foam board workshop, and it should say pick your pattern instead. There will be a quilt appraiser at the expo, she will appraise your quilts for \$75 per quilt, or \$50 each for more than one quilt. There will be a locked room where you can leave your quilts before/after the appraisal so you can attend the show. All vendor spots are filled, and there will be 2 new vendors. Volunteers are needed to fill many positions at the show. Please see Robyn Eck to sign up. Daisy will distribute raffle tickets and collect the money for them. Marilyn Ehren is the chairperson for the QUIP booth at the show. Sandy Glazer volunteered to assist Marilyn. We still need a volunteer to coordinate the raffle ticket sales at the show.

Membership: We have 73 paid members. Carmen joined as a new member last month.

Newsletter: Newsletter editor Anne Brumet wants to send out the newsletter before Christmas, please send your items to her as soon as possible. Anne will include information about making bears in the newsletter.

Charity: Barbara's cupboards are bare. Quilts were donated to a nursing home and Children's diagnostic treatment center. All Christmas items were donated. We are in need of charity quilts to be donated. Barbara has many kits for charity quilts.

BOM: Daisy will not be the BOM person for next year. Nina has offered to do it, but she will need an assistant also. We also discussed having a round robin or row robin project, if enough are interested.

New Business: There will be a planning meeting and potluck for the board on Jan. 2nd, Location to be determined. You will need to let Kay know what you are bringing. We need to find volunteers for the nominating committee in December. We also need to set a budget for 2025. Two board members volunteered to help display the raffle quilt at the Women in Distress Thrift store in Margate. Sheri will contact WID to see what days they suggest.
